So you want to be an AHA CPR Instructor!

My name is La-Von McPhee-Lopez and I'm a critical care nurse, educator, and an American Heart Association CPR instructor. I'm also the managing partner of Matters2TheHeart LLC where we train health care and non-healthcare professionals how to save a life!

I have put together this resource book to cover just about everything that you would need to know to assist you in making the decision to become an AHA CPR instructor.

BECOMING A CPR INSTRUCTOR INFORMATION

This information I am sharing is specific to becoming an AHA instructor, however, the cost will be roughly the same or may vary as to whether you are a Red Cross, American Safety and Health Institute, or an instructor with any other organization. You may be able to get some savings on your required equipment by purchasing of EBAY or Amazon. Also, it may be useful and helpful to join Facebook groups for support. When you take your CPR Instructor training with us, you are put in our Better Business Bootcamp closed Facebook group. INSTRUCTOR COURSE

The first expense you will make is taking the AHA Instructor course. There are two basic CPR instructor courses you can take and they will both cost more-or-less the same. My recommendation is to take the BLS Instructor course as the highest training of a CPR instructor of the two and will allow you to teach all of the following:

- BLS Provider
- Heartsaver CPR/AED
- Heartsaver FirstAid
- Heartsaver Bloodborne Pathogens



DIFFERENCES

HEARTSAVER: | WHAT IS IT?

It is a family of classes that includes CPR/AED, First Aid, and Bloodborne pathogens. The AHA HeartSaver courses are formatted for individuals working in a non-healthcare field who may be required to have a certification for their job

Heartsaver Instructor. This course allows you to teach first aid, CPR, and AED use to laypersons (non-medical professionals).

BLS | WHAT IS IT?

Basic Life Support covers CPR/AED as well as advanced techniques for team rescuers.

AHA BLS are targeted towards licensed professionals healthcare healthcare and students who are required by their state licensing board or employer to have a CPR certification.

BLS (Basic Life Support) Instructor. This course allows you to teach CPR, AED use, and other basic life support skills specific to medical professionals. As a BLS instructor, you will also be authorized to teach Heartsaver classes as long as you also purchase the Heartsaver curriculum.



AHA BLS are targeted towards licensed healthcare professionals and healthcare students who are required by their state licensing board or employer to have a CPR certification. BLS may also be required for non-licensed staff who works in a healthcare institution eg. Hospital, hospice, clinic, SNF etc.



PREREQUISITES

To obtain a BLS AHA instructor course, you must first have an unexpired BLS provider card. An American Red Cross or other non-AHA card certification will not be valid for this purpose. To obtain an ACLS or PALS instructor card, you must be able to hold the provider card and have an unexpired card.

ALIGNMENT

Become aligned with a Training Center. Training Centers monitor and renew instructors' certifications. They also provide instructors with certification cards to issue to students. Individuals must receive approval from a Training Center before registering for an Instructor class.

Clients who take their instructor training get aligned with our training center as long as they complete, pass the class and meet the other requirements.

TRAINING CENTERS

AHA Training Centers offer these courses. Training centers are independent entities authorized by the AHA to teach AHA courses and distribute certification cards. There are a few different types of Training Centers. The most common types are 1) Hospital/EMS services/educational institutions that train their own employees/students and 2) For-profit entrepreneurial training centers that provide training to the general public.

Cost for the course: Training centers set their own prices. Average costs are around \$375 to \$585. Business Training & Mentoring adds ons can boost costs to \$897-\$1297.'

INSTRUCTOR CURRICULUM

To issue AHA cards to your students, you will need to follow the AHA course curriculum for the type of certification you will be issuing to your students (Heartsaver/BLS) . The curriculum includes an instruction manual and video (DVD or streaming). Prices are listed below:

Ensure that you are purchasing the most up to date resources. Also please note that AHA reviews its policies and standards every 5 years and this book reflects the AHA & ECC's newest updates as of October 21, 2020.

American Heart Association requires that an instructor must be aligned with a Training Center. Training Centers are for-profit entities sanctioned by the AHA. It is recommended that you secure a TC that would agree to align you before you take your instructor class

- An Instructor Candidate application must also be submitted to the Training Center.
- Complete the online Instructor Essentials Candidate course (must have the appropriate) CPR instructor manual as the online course asks specific questions that can only be found in the manual. Upon completion, you will be asked to please bring a certificate on the first day of your instructor's class.
- 🗸 Attend Instructor class 6-8 hours. At the instructor's cost, the fee charged may cover the Instructor's Essential course, Instructor's manual, and other AHA Instructor material. If not, they may be purchased at Worldpoint, Laerdal, and AEDSuperstore. At the end of the class, candidates will take a 25-question written exam that covers what was taught in the online and in-person class. A passing grade is 84%

All clients who take our CPR Instructor class are aligned with our Training Center as long as they have taken and passed the course, completed all paperwork including the AHA Candidate application, completed the AHA Online Essentials course (passed with completion certificate) for each discipline that they have completed the course in AND met any other requirements.

All instructor training are based on the AHA and ECC 2020 new guidelines.



- ✓ Upon passing, candidates are required to teach a class within 6 months and be monitored by their Instructor or by another AHA Training Center Faulty member. I recommend teaching a class sooner rather than later so that the information is current in your head. Candidates are graded using the AHA Instructor Monitoring Tool Form. Upon passing, candidates are issued their Instructor Card within 20 days. The higher end fees are usually charged for more intense training including business training, focused mentoring and coaching over extended weeks. Coaching and support is given to assist the client in setting up their business and social media identity, marketing and branding support, budget start up and business plan.
 - Instructor Course Fee
 - Instructor Manual
 - Instructor Provider Manual
 - Essentials Key Code (non-refundable)
- Every two years instructors are required to be monitored again for renewal. There usually is a fee for this and can range from \$50 to \$100.



TRAINING EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES

Training Manikins: There are various brands of CPR manikins to choose from out there. I recommend and use the Prestan manikins for two reasons 1) they are very durable 2) as of January 2019 the AHA requires that all AHA instructors teaching adult CPR to use feedback devices that monitor compression rate and depth. The Prestan manikins have internal rate and depth monitors. They have the feedback lights on the upper right shoulder.

How many manikins you buy will depend on your budget. The AHA student-to-manikin ratio states that you can have 3 students to 1 manikin. So, a minimum of 1 adult, 1 child, and 1 infant manikin will allow you to teach a class of three. The instructor ratio is 1 instructor to 6 students.

COST OF PRESTAN FAMILY PACK (ONE ADULT, CHILD, INFANT): \$345.33

The price range for AED trainers is anywhere from \$99 to \$1,000. If you are just starting out and have a limited budget, I recommend you purchase at least 2 AEDs. Expect to pay anywhere from \$150-\$200. As with manikins, your student-to-AED ratio is 3:1. Cost: \$99.95

At minimum to get off the ground and present as a professional CPR training company, I estimate \$1500 to \$2000. This number is based on one class of 3 people. There are other minor costs for purchases essential for your start up, posters, business cards, uniform shirt (optional), folders, logo and website. The expenses above are the bare minimum needed to get off the ground.


